

Spanish School Improvement Priorities 2022 - 2023

Develop clear progression of knowledge within Spanish, ensuring sequencing of lessons allows for previous skills to be embedded and built upon.

Develop clear progression of skills within Spanish, ensuring sequencing of lessons allows for previous skills to be embedded and built upon. Implement the progression of knowledge and skills through 'I know' and 'I can' statements which are in line with the national curriculum expectations of learning.

Develop planning and teaching that facilitates adaptive learning allowing progression and challenge for all children.

Further develop teacher and TA confidence in teaching and supporting the teaching of Spanish through the use of the Primary Languages scheme.

Conduct a Spanish deep dive to monitor the planning, teaching and progression of the subject across Key Stage Two with a particular focus on the progression of knowledge and skills.

Liaise with local secondary schools to establish working partnerships for MFL teaching, creating links and access sample teaching sessions.

Establish a link with a Spanish school to be able to send emails and write to each other.

To identify days throughout the school year where Spanish culture and heritage can be celebrated and explored, developing pupil's understanding of the country further.
