Study the reproduction of plants:

For spiritual and moral development, we will...

- Pupils know that Christians believe God is omnipotent, omniscient and eternal. They know that some
 people do not believe God exists (i.e. Humanist's) and can say why i.e. Humanist's don't believe God is
 omnipotent omniscient and eternal because...
- They know that there are different types of text in the Bible and can give examples of psalms, letters
 and prophecy.
- Pupils know that Christians believe God is holy and loving but that he is also angered by sin and
 injustice. They are aware that not all Christians agree about what God is like but that they all try and
 follow his teachings as they understand it. They can explain that this is why Christians can respond
 differently both in reaction to social injustice but also in styles of worship and church building.
- Pupils can give an example of how biblical ideas about holiness love or forgiveness have made a
 difference in the world for example Coventry Cathedral.
