Evolution and Inheritance

Knowledge

- Evolution is the process of change in living things over time.
- That we inherit some features from our mothers and others from our fathers. We may share features of both parents.
- Characteristics are passed on from one generation to the next over time.
- How to identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.
- The variety in living things can be artificially controlled by selective breeding.
- Selective breeding is a version of what happens in nature but is controlled by humans.
- Some beneficial adaptations in some animals and plants.
- Charles Darwin, the originator of the theory of evolution.
- Darwin's great breakthrough was to realise that even the slightest variation amongst a species gave some a better chance of surviving than others in their environment.
- Animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

What can we learn from a Mandir?

- Discuss the place of worship in the life of a Hindu believer, and how this may take place in the home or in a mandir.
