On behalf of myself and everyone at St Matthew's we would like to say a huge thank you to parents for supporting the ongoing hard work that staff put in daily to ensure that every pupil is provided with the opportunities needed to reach their potential. In our recent Ofsted inspection it was recognised that, 'leaders, staff and governors share high expectations for all pupils, including those with SEND' and that 'pupils who need extra support get the help they need. This means that all pupils achieve well in a wide range of subjects.'

When observing reading across the school, the Ofsted inspector also acknowledged the rigour and diligence of all teaching staff to ensure that SEND pupils needs are identified and met, stating, 'Teachers spot those children who are finding reading a little more difficult. They include those pupils with SEND. They are then given the support they need and catch up.' We were delighted that the inspector recognised the hard work and dedication of staff and pupils with SEND at St Matthew's and again would like to thank parents for supporting us in being able to achieve the outcomes we and the pupils achieve.
