Prejudice

Preconceived opinion that is not based on reason.

Justice

Fair behaviour or treatment.

Tolerance

Sympathy for beliefs or practices differing from ones own.

White privilege

Inherent advantages possessed by a white person because of skin colour.

Outcomes

- Recognise religious responses to racism.
- Recognise links between religious texts,
 values and behaviour that are relevant in reducing racism.
- Explain ways in which prejudice and racism can be reduced, linking to religious teachings.
